**EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION OF THE CITY MANAGER/DIRECTOR OF EMERGENCY
SERVICES OF THE CITY OF SAN BRUNO
PROCLAIMING THE EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, I am the City Manager for the City of San Bruno, and in my capacity as the Director of Emergency Services I am empowered to proclaim a local emergency and to make and issue emergency orders, rules, and regulations to protect life and property and to combat, prevent, and mitigate the impacts of an emergency in accordance with state law and San Bruno Municipal Code Chapter 2.48; and

WHEREAS, as the Director of Emergency Services of the City, I find that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property have arisen within the City, caused by the severe winter storms and rainfall commencing on or about 2p.m. on the day of December 31, 2022.

WHEREAS, the City is already operating under a local emergency due to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the above facts give rise to conditions of extreme peril to the safety and health of persons and to property within the City; and

WHEREAS, these conditions are or are likely to be beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of the City; and

WHEREAS, the efforts required to prepare for, respond to, mitigate, and recover from severe storm conditions and flooding, as well as the spread of COVID-19 infections will impose extraordinary burdens on City resources and expenses, thereby diverting resources from day-to-day operations and mutual aid assistance; and

WHEREAS, due to the above conditions of extreme peril, I find it necessary and appropriate to proclaim a second local emergency and use extraordinary measures to protect the public peace, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, time is of the essence due to the perils resulting from the threat of this emergency and the San Bruno City Council is not in session and cannot immediately be called into session.

NOW, THEREFORE, I order and declare that a public safety emergency now exists throughout the City and call upon the City's emergency organization to exercise its powers, functions, and duties, as prescribed by law.

ATTACHMENT 1

I FURTHER ORDER AND DECLARE that I hereby delegate to the Chief of the San Bruno Police Department and to the Chief of the San Bruno Fire Department the authority to issue additional orders for the protection of life and property.

I FURTHER ORDER AND DECLARE that this emergency order shall be deemed to continue to exist for the next seven (7) days, and thereafter by ratification of the City Council, until its termination is proclaimed.
