## FLAG DISPLAY POLICY

City of San Bruno

---

### **SECTION 1: PURPOSE**

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidelines for displaying the United States of America, State of California, and commemorative and ceremonial flags and banners at sites and facilities under the jurisdiction of the City of San Bruno.

In adopting this policy, the San Bruno City Council declares that the City of San Bruno's flagpoles are not intended to serve as a forum for free expression of the public, but rather for the display of National, State and any commemorative or ceremonial flags and banners as may be authorized by Resolution by the San Bruno City Council as an expression of the City Council's official views.

### **SECTION 2: STANDARDS**

- 2.1 No other flag shall be placed above the United States Flag, and no other flag shall be larger than the United States Flag. Where the California State Flags are used, they shall be of the same size as the United States Flag.
- 2.2 The City Manager is authorized to order that the United States Flag, California State Flag and any commemorative flags on display be lowered to half-staff by the order of the President of the United States, or by the Governor of the State of California.
- 2.3 Commemorative or Ceremonial Flags and Banners
  - 2.3.1 Commemorative or ceremonial flags and banners shall only be displayed at a designated San Bruno City facility.
  - 2.3.2 Commemorative or ceremonial flags and banners shall be displayed for a period of time at a designated San Bruno city facility authorized by resolution of the City Council.
  - 2.3.3 The City will not display a commemorative or ceremonial flag or banner based on a request from a third party, unless approved by Council resolution, nor will the City use its flagpoles to sponsor the expression of a third party.
