a. Fire Update – AB 1234 training is available for Committee members and there are two dates for the Webinar sessions. The SBFD and SBPD responded to well over 1,000 calls in just a 1½ week period during the storms because of downed trees, power outages and landslides etc. The FD has an extensive Mutual Aid system with several cities in San Mateo County for more efficient use of their apparatus and personnel.

b. Police – Garrison works with a non-profit called “Life Moves” to get homeless people into housing. Three were able to get into housing ahead of the storms. Drone equipment is being used successfully by the PD and other County agencies. PD has a new emblem and will be putting it on uniforms and vehicles.

c. Red Cross – Doug has been deployed many places during the previous stormy weather. He spent time in Santa Cruz EOC discussing what supplies might be needed there as well as the State Headquarters of the Red Cross in Vallejo and other locations.
