RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH TYLER TECHNOLOGIES, INC. FOR THE UPGRADE TO ENTERPRISE RESOURCE PLANNING (ERP) MUNIS SOFTWARE, ALONG WITH RELATED BUSINESS PROCESS AND IMPLEMENTATION SERVICES, AND SUPPORT SERVICES; AND

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH OPENGOV FOR PROCUREMENT SOFTWARE, ALONG WITH RELATED BUSINESS PROCESS AND IMPLEMENTATION SERVICES, AND SUPPORT SERVICES, FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$800,000.

WHEREAS the City Council adopted the 2022-23 Operating and FY2022-26 Capital Improvement Program Budget on June 28, 2022, and

WHEREAS the 2022-26 Capital Improvement Program Budget identifies the Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system as reaching to its end of life requiring an upgrade, and

WHEREAS the Finance Department has evaluated a number of financial software packages and has determined that an upgrade to MUNIS software will best meet the needs of the organization, and

WHEREAS the Finance Department evaluated procurement software and has determined that OpenGov offers the best system to best meet the needs of the organization, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the San Bruno City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and enter into agreements with Tyler Technologies - MUNIS Software for Enterprise Resource Planning and OpenGov for Procurement Software along with related business process and implementation services, and support services, in an amount not to exceed \$800,000.
