## RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE HUNTINGTON / SAN ANTONIO BICYCLE CORRIDOR PROJECT AS COMPLETE, AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF NOTICE OF COMPLETION WITH THE SAN MATEO COUNTY RECORDER'S OFFICE, AND AUTHORIZING RELEASE OF THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT RETENTION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$48,502.24

**WHEREAS,** the City's Capital Improvement Program includes an approved capital project to improve the pedestrian and bicycle network along Huntington Avenue and San Antonio Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, the Huntington / San Antonio Bicycle Corridor Project is an established CIP project funded through the TDA Article 3, Gas Tax, Measure A and General Fund Capital Reserve with a total approved project budget of \$1,485,667 which included design, construction, staff management, project contingency, construction management and inspection services, and material testing; and

**WHEREAS**, change orders were issued for items such as work related to performing additional pavement rehabilitation and adjusting storm drain systems due to existing utility conflict; and

WHEREAS, the total expenditure for the project is approximately \$1,194,579; and

WHEREAS, the project has a realized cost savings of approximately \$291,088; and

**WHEREAS**, all construction work as part of this contract has been completed to the satisfaction of the City's project management team; and

**WHEREAS**, the construction contract requires the filing of a Notice of Completion of this project with the San Mateo County Recorder's Office and release of the construction contract retention in the amount of \$48,502.24 upon the acceptance of the project as complete.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council accepts the Huntington / San Antonio Bicycle Corridor Project as complete, authorizes the filing of Notice of Completion with the San Mateo County Recorder's Office, and authorizes release of the construction contract retention in the amount of \$48,502.24.
