RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN BRUNO DIRECTING STAFF TO INITIATE THE NOTICE, HEARING AND PROTEST PROCESS REQUIRED BY PROPOSITION 218 FOR THE PROPOSED FY 2023-24 SOLID WASTE RATE INCREASE

WHEREAS, the existing Franchise Agreement for Solid Waste Collection Services between the City of San Bruno and Recology San Bruno became effective on January 1, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Franchise Agreement includes annual adjustments to service recipient rates including a 2% rate adjustment effective July 1, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Bruno and Recology San Bruno have negotiated the rate adjustment for FY 2023-24 to be reflective of higher-than-normal inflation and new and enhanced services, including Recology San Bruno taking over customer billing and collection of payments and a franchise fee for street sweeping and catch basin waste removal, which calculates to a total 9.58% increase effective July 1, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the proposed solid waste rate increase is subject to Section 6 of Article XIIID of the California Constitution (Proposition 218), which requires a public hearing and majority protest process following at least 45 days' mailed notice to the solid waste collection service customers.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of San Bruno directs staff to initiate the notice, hearing, and protest process as required by Proposition 218 for the proposed FY 2023-24 solid waste rate increase to be effective July 1, 2023.
