**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN BRUNO TERMINATING
THE LOCAL EMERGENCY DECLARED BY THE CITY IN RESPONSE TO THE LATE 2022
TO 2023 WINTER STORMS**

WHEREAS, on January 4, 2023, as part of the State of California's response to address the severe winter storms related to a series of atmospheric river systems striking California, Governor Gavin Newsom declared a State of Emergency to make additional resources available and formalize emergency actions across multiple state agencies and departments; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager, acting as Director of Emergency Services, declared a Local State of Emergency on January 3, 2023, in response to the late 2022 to 2023 winter storms; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Bruno may potentially still experience residual storm-related expenses, there are no additional active threats to the City related to the late 2022 to 2023 winter storms. Therefore, the City desires to terminate its Local State of Emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Council hereby declares that the Local State of Emergency for the late 2022 to 2023 winter storms, which was declared on January 3, 2023, shall be terminated as of May 9, 2023.
