**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN BRUNO APPROVING
THE NEWSPAPER RACK AND ENCLOSURE MODELS AND LOCATIONS AND
DETERMINING THE PROJECT IS EXEMPT UNDER THE CALIFORNIA
ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT**

WHEREAS, the City of San Bruno's (City) San Mateo Avenue Conceptual Streetscape Plan (Plan), adopted in 2019, provides design guidance for the public right-of-way to support the City's goals of beautifying the public realm, supporting local businesses, spurring investment within the downtown core, enhancing the downtown's character, and increasing the attractiveness of the downtown as a destination; and

WHEREAS, the Plan includes a condition assessment of the current San Mateo Avenue streetscape, which was categorized by the community as "run down" with "...precast-concrete trash receptacles that are unsightly and do not provide for recycling, as well as several mismatched trash receptacles, newspaper racks that are in disrepair..."; and

WHEREAS, staff prepared a proposal for a near-term project within the Plan that could be completed prior to the overall streetscape implementation which included the replacement of trash receptacles and the installation of enclosures around the newspaper racks on San Mateo Avenue within the downtown corridor; and

WHEREAS, the trash receptacles were replaced in Spring 2022; and

WHEREAS, staff worked with a professional design firm to create custom design options for the newspaper rack enclosures and engaged the community to vote for their preferred design; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends replacing the existing newspaper racks due to poor condition and lack of modern security features such as locking bins; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends the newspaper rack enclosure design option in alignment with the community's preference and the newspaper rack model in alignment with the design recommendations in San Bruno Municipal Code Section 8.32.040; and

WHEREAS, there is sufficient budget in the adopted CIP Project #60027: Downtown Trash Receptacles & Newspaper Racks & Enclosures as part of the City's Adopted Fiscal Year 2023-24 Operating and Capital Improvements Program (CIP) Budgets; and

WHEREAS, the contracts for the purchase and installation of the newspaper racks and enclosures are within the approval authority of the City Manager and the Public Works Director; and

WHEREAS, this action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15301(c), existing facilities which exempts minor alterations of existing streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities. This project will not cause an expansion of an existing use of the streets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby approves the newspaper rack and enclosure models shown in Exhibit A, to be installed at the locations shown in Exhibit B, with such modifications as deemed appropriate by the City Manager.

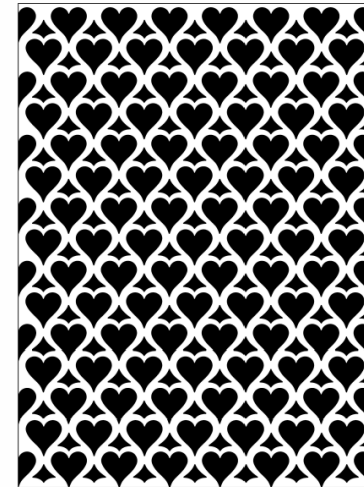
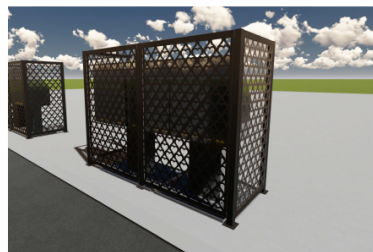
Newspaper Rack Model:
