**ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF SAN BRUNO,  
CALIFORNIA, TO AMEND AND RESTATE SECTION 2.04.015(B) OF THE  
MUNICIPAL CODE TO ESTABLISH TERM LIMITS FOR THE MAYOR AND  
CITY COUNCILMEMBERS**

**THE PEOPLE OF CITY OF SAN BRUNO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** Purpose.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to establish term limits for the mayor and city councilmembers.

**SECTION 2.** Chapter 2.04.015(B) of the San Bruno Municipal Code is hereby repealed, restated and amended as follows:

No person may hold the office of mayor for more than six terms in succession and no person may hold the office councilmember for more than three terms in succession. This provision does not prohibit holding an office for more than twelve years, provided that the terms of office are not consecutive. “Term of office” as used in this section is defined as a four-year term for the office of councilmember and defined as a two-year term for the office of mayor. For the purpose of determining the number of terms of office, only those terms of office occurring after December 1, 2022 shall be counted.

**SECTION 3.** If any provision, clause, sentence or paragraph of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provision of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect 10 days after the City Council declares the results of the vote at the November 8, 2022, election.
