**RESOLUTION APPROVING VARIOUS CURB MARKING:**

• **RED, WHITE AND BLUE CURB STRIPING ON BAYHILL CIRCLE**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Title VII, Section 7.08.040, the Traffic Safety and Parking Committee (TSPC) is tasked with reviewing and recommending to the City Council areas in which parking is prohibited or restricted on streets within the public right of way; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Title VII, Section 7.08.050, of the San Bruno Municipal Code, any action of the City Council following a recommendation from the Department of Public Works and the Traffic Safety and Parking Committee (TSPC) shall be taken by resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Title VII, Section 7.12.030 of the San Bruno Municipal Code grants the City Traffic Engineer the duty and responsibility for placing and maintaining traffic control devices he or she deems necessary to guide or warn traffic based on engineering principles and investigations; and

**WHEREAS**, painting red, white and blue curb striping on Bayhill Circle would improve traffic circulations, pedestrian safety and fire access; and

**WHEREAS**, the Traffic Safety and Parking Committee reviewed and concurred with the proposed curb striping at the location mentioned above.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council hereby adopts a resolution approving the following:

1. On the north side of Bayhill Circle, fifteen feet (15') of red curb striping starting from the beginning of curb return in advance of marked midblock crosswalk westward to the end of curb return (edge of ADA curb ramp); twenty feet (20') of red curb from the edge of curb ramp to the edge of driveway; sixty feet (60') of red curb from the westerly edge of driveway to the middle of curb return of passenger loading duck out; forty feet (40') of white curb from the middle of curb return duck out to the edge of ADA passenger loading parking space; thirty feet (30') of blue curb for ADA passenger loading parking space; forty five feet (45') of red curb to the edge of driveway; as shown on Attachment 6 to the Council Report;
2. On the south side of Bayhill Circle, fifteen feet (15') of red curb striping starting from the beginning of curb return in advance of marked midblock crosswalk westward to the edge of ADA curb ramp; sixty feet (60') of red curb from the edge of ADA curb ramp to the edge of driveway; twenty feet (20') of red curb from the edge of driveway to the beginning of the private access road shown on Attachment 6 to the Council Report.
