**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS
FOR THE PURCHASE OF ELEVEN VEHICLES WITH RELATED EQUIPMENT
INSTALLATION AND CUSTOMIZATION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$956,000**

WHEREAS, the replacement of City owned vehicles is necessary due to constant usage causing the vehicles to reach the end of their useful life; and

WHEREAS, eleven (11) vehicles were approved in the FY 2022-23 Operating Budget and are being presented to the City Council for authorization to purchase; and

WHEREAS, the total number of vehicles to be replaced in FY 2022-23 is eleven (11); and

WHEREAS, staff is acquiring 10 vehicles from National Auto Fleet Group of Watsonville, California through a government purchasing cooperative referred from California's statewide contracts for fleet vehicles, in compliance with the State Contract Code and the City's purchasing regulations; and

WHEREAS, staff is acquiring one (1) specialized medium street sweeper from Green Space Machines Inc. of San Diego, California, a sole source supplier of the vehicle; and

WHEREAS, outfitting of the Police Department patrol vehicles, including the emergency traffic lighting, communications, and storage components, will be provided by Lehr Auto Electric of Pittsburg, California; and

WHEREAS, outfitting of the Public Works vehicles will be completed by the following companies: TelePath Corporation of Fremont, California; Scelzi Enterprises of Fresno, California; and Knapheide Corp of Tracy, California, due to needing a variety of specialized needs; and

WHEREAS, the total cost to replace these vehicles is \$956,000, which includes the base cost of the vehicles and all costs for equipment outfitting, sales tax, license, registration, and delivery, funded from an appropriation of available funds in the General Equipment Revolving Fund and is within the FY 2022-23 adopted equipment budget amount of \$956,000; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into agreements for the purchase of eleven vehicles with related equipment installation and customization in an amount not to exceed \$956,000.
