**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AMEND THE
FY2022-23 STORMWATER OPERATING CONTRACTUAL SERVICES BUDGET FOR
STORMWATER SYSTEM SPOT REPAIR SERVICES WITH
C2R ENGINEERING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$110,000 TO
COMPLETE STORM DRAIN AND SINKHOLE REPAIRS AT 2850 SNEATH LANE,
APPROPRIATING \$110,000 FROM THE GENERAL FUND CAPITAL RESERVE FUND,
ACCEPTING A STORM DRAIN EASEMENT DEED FROM THE PROPERTY OWNER,
AND DIRECTING THE EXECUTION AND FILING OF A CERTIFICATION OF
ACCEPTANCE**

WHEREAS, the City of San Bruno desires to utilize the services of a well-qualified contractor to assist the City with repair services for a sink hole at 2850 Sneath Lane (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, Public Works staff were alerted to the sink hole on May 3, 2022, and after a field investigation, determined the sinkhole was caused by erosion underground from a failed dilapidated corrugated-metal storm drain pipe; and

WHEREAS, Public Works crews have temporarily secured the sinkhole with metal plates to prevent any issues with damage or injury until the site is permanently repaired; and

WHEREAS, on January 22, 2019, the City Council approved a five-year on-call Stormwater Spot Repair Services contract with the engineering and construction firm of C2R Engineering of Mountain View, California; and

WHEREAS, the approved FY 2022-23 Stormwater Contractual Services Operating Budget provided \$250,000 for stormwater system spot repairs, with such funds committed for other storm drain line failures for the year and there are no additional stormwater operating funds to cover this repair before the rainy season; and

WHEREAS, the cost to repair the sinkhole location is estimated at \$100,000 and City staff are planning for \$10,000 in contingency for unanticipated repairs for a total project budget of \$110,000; and

WHEREAS, to the additional cost requires an amendment to and increase of the FY2022-23 Stormwater Operating Contractual Services Budget for stormwater system spot repairs with C2R Engineering in the amount of \$110,000, to the FY2020-21 budget of \$250,000, for a revised FY2022-23 total contract repair amount of \$360,000; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to accept a Storm Drain Easement Deed from the property owner to clarify the rights on the Property; and

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 27281 requires that the City execute and file with the San Mateo County Clerk-Recorder a Certificate of Acceptance for the Grant of Easement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby authorizes the

City Manager to amend the FY2022-23 Stormwater Operating Contractual Services Budget for Stormwater System Spot Repair Services with C2R Engineering in the amount of \$110,000 to complete storm drain and sinkhole repairs at 2850 Sneath Lane and appropriate \$110,000 from the General Fund Capital Reserve Fund.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby accepts the Storm Drain Easement Deed as set forth in Exhibit "A" hereto and incorporated herein for stormdrain operation and maintenance purposes, and the City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute the Certificate of Acceptance for the Storm Drain Easement Deed on behalf of the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is hereby directed to file the Stormwater Easement Deed and Certificate of Acceptance with the San Mateo County Clerk-Recorder. .
