**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF SAN BRUNO SETTING PRIORITIES FOR FILING
WRITTEN ARGUMENTS AND AUTHORIZING
REBUTTALS FOR A CITY MEASURE THAT PROPOSES A
CITY CHARTER BE ADOPTED TO CHANGE THE CITY
OF SAN BRUNO FROM A GENERAL LAW CITY TO A
CHARTER CITY AND TO AUTHORIZE A REAL
PROPERTY TRANSFER TAX AND THAT PROPOSES
ADOPTION OF AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A
COMMERCIAL REAL PROPERTY TRANSFER TAX**

WHEREAS, by prior resolution, the City Council called a general municipal election for November 8, 2022 (the “Election”), to be consolidated with the statewide general election to be held on that same date; and

WHEREAS, by prior resolution, the City Council submitted to the voters at the Election a measure that proposes a City Charter be adopted to change the City of San Bruno from a general law city to a charter city and to authorize a real property transfer tax and that proposes adoption of an ordinance authorizing a commercial real property transfer tax (the “Measure”).

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF SAN BRUNO, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. The City Council authorizes

to file a written argument in favor of or against the Measure as specified above, in accordance with Article 4, Chapter 3, Division 9 of the Elections Code of the State of California and to change the argument until and including the date fixed by the City Clerk after which no arguments for or against the Measure may be submitted to the City Clerk. If it is proposed that three or more members of the City Council will author an argument, then the proposed argument shall be submitted to the City Council for approval in a public meeting of the City Council.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to Section 9285 of the California Elections Code of the State of California, when the City Clerk has selected the arguments for and against the Measure that will be printed and distributed to the voters, the City Clerk shall send copies of the argument in favor of the Measure to the author(s) of the argument against, and copies of the argument against to the author(s) of the argument in favor. The author(s), or a majority of the authors, may

prepare and submit rebuttal arguments not exceeding 250 words or may authorize, in writing, others to submit a rebuttal argument. The rebuttal arguments shall be filed with the City Clerk, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the person(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers, not more than 10 days after the final date for filing direct arguments. Rebuttal arguments shall not be signed by more than 5 persons. Rebuttal arguments shall be printed in the same manner as the direct arguments. Each rebuttal argument shall immediately follow the direct argument that it seeks to rebut. The provisions of this Section 2 shall apply only to the Election concerning the Measure set forth in this Resolution and shall then be repealed.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
