RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A JOINT USE AGREEMENT WITH THE SAN BRUNO PARK SCHOOL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the City of San Bruno and the San Bruno Park School District agree that the adequately maintained recreational facilities and programs are beneficial to the residents of the City and to those who reside within the geographical boundaries of the District; and

WHEREAS, the District and the City each own certain indoor and outdoor facilities, such as athletic fields, play areas, community rooms, gymnasiums, classrooms, and other facilities (hereinafter, collectively referred to as "Facilities") which are suitable for District and City recreational programs and community use; and

WHEREAS, the City and the District have a well-established history of working together to ensure that their respective Facilities are available and utilized for the common good and for the enhanced benefit of the community; and

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2007 and December 15, 2011, the City and the District agreed to arrangements for the joint use of the Facilities and have since been operating under those terms and conditions; and

WHEREAS, sections 10900 et seq. of the Education Code authorize cities and school districts to maintain and operate joint use playgrounds and outdoor playing fields in order to reduce capital and operational costs to both governmental jurisdictions and provide recreational areas for the community as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the City and the District wish to enter into this Agreement to provide for the joint use of their respective Facilities and set forth their respective obligations with respect to Facilities maintenance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the San Bruno City Council hereby adopts this resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a Joint Use Agreement with the San Bruno Park School District.
