


Because of limited testing capacity, the number of cases detected through testing represents only a small portion of the total number of likely cases in the County. COVID-19 data are reported as timely, accurately, and completely as we have available. Data are updated as we receive information that is more complete and will change over time as we learn more. Cases are lab-confirmed COVID-19 cases reported to San Mateo County Public Health by providers, commercial laboratories, and academic laboratories, including reporting results through the California Reportable Disease Information Exchange. A lab-confirmed case is defined as detection of SARS-CoV-2 RNA in a clinical specimen using a molecular amplification detection test. Cases are counted by episode date; episode date is defined as the earliest of: case symptom onset date, sample collection date, date of laboratory result, or date of death. Deaths reported in this dashboard include only San Mateo County residents; death data last updated August 31, 2022.



COVID 19 Vaccinations of San Mateo County Residents



Vaccine Doses Administered by Date




Récipient Vaccination Status by Date
