## RESOLUTION NO. 2022 -

Resolution Authorizing the Receipt and Expenditure of \$80,000 in California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) Grant Funds to Facilitate the Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP)

**WHEREAS**, The San Bruno Police Department is charged with providing for the safety and security of the people within City limits and beyond; and

**WHERAS**, there are substantial traffic safety challenges on San Bruno roadways that negatively impact that safety and security; and

**WHEREAS**, increased education and enforcement regarding impaired and other unsafe driving practices can reduce those negative impacts; and

**WHEREAS,** funding the overtime, equipment, and other expenses associated with this education and enforcement presents a fiscal challenge for the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the San Bruno Police Department and the California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) have collaborated to establish goals and objectives for the 2022-2023 Federal Fiscal Year to have a positive impact on traffic safety challenges in San Bruno; and

**WHEREAS**, the San Bruno Police Department has applied for and received an offer of an OTS Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) Grant #PT23166, providing funding in furtherance of these goals and objectives.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Chief of Police for the San Bruno Police Department or his/her designee is authorized to execute on behalf of the City of San Bruno the attached agreement, including any extensions or amendments thereof and any subsequent contract with the state in relation thereto.

**IT IS AGREED** that any liability arising out of the performance of this contract, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California, and OTS disclaim responsibility for any such liability.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

IT IS ALSO AGREED that this award is not subject to local hiring freezes.
